• Scholarships

- Scholarship Meeting is on April 24th. Watch deadlines, prepare resumes, and get transcripts and reference letters ready. (For help see Guidance at lunch).
- Apply to the Annual Kent Scholarship. This is a must. There are 2 parts for the Kent. Part 1 needs to be RECEIVED by the KENT FOUNDATION on <u>IUNE 1st</u>. Part 2 needs to be RECEIVED by <u>IUNE 30th</u>.
- ** <u>IMPORTANT</u> If you won any scholarship from a Post-Secondary School or other scholarships please bring in a copy of what you won so it can be used in our PP Presentation at the Graduation Ceremony.
- **Grad Fees are \$120.00** & \$20.00 for your date if not a 2019 BHS Grad.
 - Cheques are made out to Bathurst High School. Included in the Grad Fees are:
 - 2019 Yearbook Available in October-November 2019
 - Graduation, Prom, and Safe Grad Activities, Prizes (only grads can win a prize and you need to be present to win), food, cleaning of gowns, decorations, flowers, certificates, diploma cases, printing, etc.
 - If you only plan on coming to the graduation ceremony the fee is \$75.00 – you will not receive a yearbook.
- Guidance Department has lots of dresses available if you need one and they also have some suits.

 - o Grads only
 - o It is FREE!
 - o Most Likely to & The King and Queen Awards are presented.
 - o Grad Shield unveiled.

- Activity Awards Ceremony also Tuesday May 28th @ 6:30
 - o Students and Parents are welcome and encouraged to attend.
 - o It is FREE!
 - o Male and Female Grad of the year will be announced
- Last day of classes are June 7^{th} while exam week is June 10^{th} 14^{th}

- Report Cards go out on Thursday June 20th BHS Gymnasium
- Graduation Day at Bathurst High School is on Friday June 21st @ 3:00PM. All Graduates need to be in the School's aymnasium at 2:00
- Prom starts at 9:00 12:30 on Friday June 21st
- Safe Grad starts at 1:30 AM on Saturday June 22nd and finishes at McDonald's at 6:00 AM.
- <u>Media Permission Form</u> must be turned in to main office or your name is left off the grad list \odot . Please check with Elaine at the Office to make sure she has your form.

GRAD PACKS

- o Your official Grad pack will be given out the first week in June.
- Inside you will find 4 tickets to graduation, a single prom ticket for your date (only needed if you date is not a 2019 graduate), a numbered piece of paper (you need this for your car at prom).
- Extra Tickets you will receive 4 tickets to graduation. If you need extra tickets **you** will need to come and see Mr. MacDonald personally and sign your name for more. **No emails or phone calls accepted**. Extra tickets will be given out after the mandatory grad rehearsal on Tuesday June 20th.
- **Grad fees & School Fees** need to be paid before you can graduate.
- Right to refuse the administration has the right to refuse anyone from attending graduation, prom, and safe grad ceremonies.
- All guests must be signed in by Mr. MacDonald just come see me.
- In order to come to safe grad you must come to prom and stay at prom.
